- Online: You can order your repeat prescription online through Patient Access. Please contact reception to get your personnel account log in ID.

Telephone Access

The receptionist records your telephone number and the doctor will ring you back after surgery. **Please note that medically urgent calls will be taken at any time**. In this case it is important that you provide the receptionist with sufficient information to prioritise your call.

<u>Results</u>

You may telephone the surgery for test results on Option 2 between **12:00 - 1:00pm Monday - Friday**. Please note for confidentiality reasons we cannot give out a patient's test results to family or friends unless consent is given to the nurse by the patient. The nurse will make a record of this in the patient's notes.

Disabled Access

Registrations

Moy Health Centre can register patients who live within their practice boundary. Reception staff will ask you for your address you are living at to check if you fall within the boundary for registering.

You will need to complete a set of HSCR1 registration forms and Health Questionnaire – you will also be asked to provide some evidence to go along with your registration forms. E.g. Passport, proof of address and a brief summary from your previous practice. Once registered your new HCN health card will take 2 to 4 weeks to arrive at your address.

Any patients who have never registered with a GP in Northern Ireland or UK before will need to attend the NINES service in South Tyrone Hospital – Contact 028 3756 1370 to make an appointment.

Abuse Or Violence

Staff are here to help you. We encourage a cordial, caring and professional relationship with all our patients. However, if a patient becomes verbally abusive towards our staff, they will receive a written warning informing them they will be removed from the GP list if their behaviour does not improve. If a patient is physically abusive towards our staff they will automatically be removed from the GP list.

We have much better facilities for diagnosing your illness and for treating you at Moy Health Centre. However, if you are completely housebound and unable to visit the Health Centre and need to see a doctor, please telephone the health Centre before 10am to request a Home Visit. Telephoning early will help us to plan the day's house calls.

Telephone Triage Appointments

The Health Centre operates a telephone triage from 8:30am until calls have reached capacity. When calls have reached capacity, you may be advised to contact us the next day unless it is Medically Urgent.

To make a telephone appointment with our practice please telephone from 8:30am on 028 8744 0376 option 4. The reception staff have been asked to get as much clinical information from you as possible, in order to direct your query to the most appropriate person.
